

EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME

Brexit

With the impending BREXIT, EEA Nationals and their dependants living in the UK will have to register themselves as being resident in the UK.

You are required to apply for settled or pre-settled status even if you currently hold a residence permit (Blue Card) or biometric residence permit (BRP) confirming your right to reside in the UK.

EU settlement scheme

The scheme enables EU citizens resident in the UK and their dependents to obtain the UK immigration status they require to continue living and working in the UK after the official exit and effects thereof on 31 December 2020 or 30 June 2021.

Eligibility for settled and pre-settled status

If you have been in the UK for over 5 years or hold permanent residence, you can apply for settled status. However, if you have been in the UK for less than 5 years you can apply for pre-settled status and then switch to settled status when you have completed your five years.

EEA nationals and non-EEA national family members who hold permanent residence or do not have any valid stay in the UK can apply for settled status in the UK.

Application Process

- Apply using App EU Exit:ID Document
- The app will scan your passport and take your pictures
- A single use code will be sent either by email or phone provided in the application to access the profile
- Provide confirmation of your criminal/character history and confirm that you are not a threat to national security
- Up to 10 documents to show your residence in the UK – this will depend on the Treaty Right you were exercising
- Your National Insurance number is required

Current Fees:

Applicants 16 or over	£65
Applicants under 16	£32.50
If you hold a valid Permanent Residence	£0

- **No fee is required when the scheme is fully open on 30 March 2019**
- **If you have already paid a refund will be provided.**

Successful completion of the application:

- You will receive a letter from the Home Office electronically which will confirm your Indefinite Leave to Remain in the UK or pre-settled status.

Outstanding HO decisions and applications already submitted:

- Any other application submitted to the Home Office will not be considered
- A refund will be issued for any pending applications sent to the Home Office
- If you withdraw any application – you will **not** get a refund
